He was a US Army Veteran of WWII and a member of the Jesse C. Lynch Memorial American Legion Post #71. Mr. Turner worked as principal at Summerfield Elementary School for over 30 years. He loved children and was dedicated to education. Mr. Turner was a loving father and grandfather who enjoyed playing tennis and serving his Church.
