



Hugh Edward Eggersman

January 9, 1949 - July 15, 2021

North Augusta, SC – Memorial Services for Hugh Edward Eggersman, 72, who entered into rest July 15, 2021, will be conducted Monday afternoon at 4 o'clock from the Posey Funeral Chapel, Dr. Paul W. Noe officiating. The family will receive friends at the funeral home one hour prior to the service.

Mr. Eggersman was a graduate of North Augusta High School and is a member of the North Augusta Football Hall of Fame. He attended the University of Southern Mississippi where he continued his stellar football career earning his spot in the University of Southern Mississippi's Football Hall of Fame and National Lineman of the week.

Mr. Eggersman retired from Savannah River Site after 25+ years of service. He was most happy when spending time with his family, most of all his grandchildren. His favorite activities were fishing, riding motorcycles, playing tennis, and running. He was preceded in death by his parents, Edward and Dorothy Eggersman.

Survivors include his beautiful wife of 41 years, Priscilla Eggersman; daughters, Whitney Eggersman, Leighton (Jeremiah) Jones, Jennifer Devall, Cindy (Lonnie) Smith and Tracy (David) Thompson; eleven grandchildren; two sisters, Christy (Kenneth) Gordan and Sharron Fairbrother.

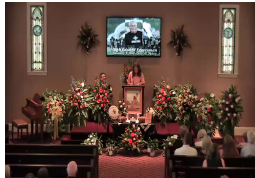

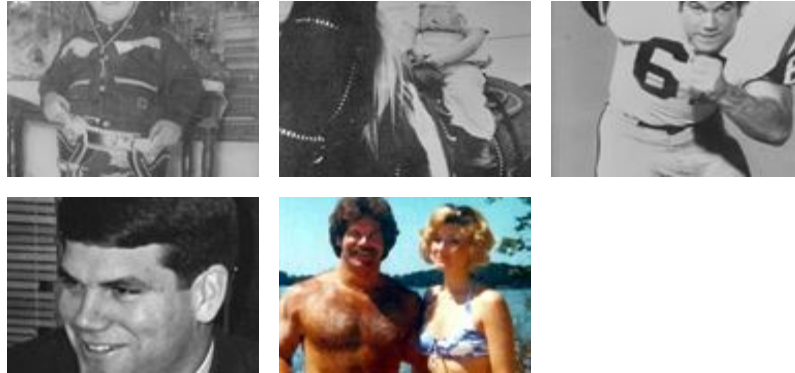
