



J. Robert "Bob" Bolton

October 13, 1942 - August 14, 2018

North Augusta, SC – Funeral Services for Mr. J. Robert “Bob” Bolton, 75, who entered into rest August 14, 2018 will be conducted Saturday afternoon at 2 o’clock in First Baptist Church of North Augusta with Veterans Honors. Dr. Randy Cooper and Rev. Roy Kiser officiating. The family will receive friends at First Baptist Church of North Augusta Thursday evening from 5 until 8. On Friday evening during the first North Augusta High School Yellow Jackets’ football game, The Bolton family will be recognized for the love, commitment and dedication Bob gave to the football program at North Augusta High School. The family request that those attending the funeral service, to please wear red and black for the Georgia Bulldog's or Black and Gold for the North Augusta Yellow Jacket's.

Mr. Bolton was a life-long resident of North Augusta and was a U. S. Navy Veteran. He enjoyed playing golf, an avid Georgia Bulldog fan and will always be remembered as being a loving husband, father, “Pap” and loyal friend. He was preceded in death by his parents, Jack and Lillouise Branch Bolton; a brother, Ronny Bolton; a sister, Carolyn DeHart; his step-mother, Dorothy Bolton.

A former member of Sweetwater Baptist Church, Mr. Bolton was an active member of First Baptist Church of North Augusta where he formerly served as a Deacon, Chairman of Finance Committee, Secretary of Board of Deacons, Stewardship Committee and Sunday School teacher.

Mr. Bolton was a member of the North Augusta High School Class of 1961

and enthusiastically supported the North Augusta Yellow Jackets. Throughout the past decade, Bob served as sideline radio reporter for North Augusta High School's football games. In 2015, Bob was recognized with the Sertoma Athlete of Distinction Award and was inducted into the North Augusta Sports Hall of Fame. In 2018, the North Augusta Sports Hall of Fame, sponsored by Meybohm Realtors, established a scholarship in Bob's honor "The Bob Bolton Award", which recognizes outstanding coaching, mentoring, sponsorship, and participation in North Augusta athletics.

Mr. Bolton loved his community and was involved in numerous community projects. He was a member of the North Augusta Chamber of Commerce, where he served on the Board of Directors and as an Ambassador of the Membership Committee. Mr. Bolton was appointed by the City of North Augusta to serve on the Riverfront Development Committee and North Augusta 2000 Committee.

In 1976, he began his 38-year real estate career in North Augusta with Fallaw-Woosley Realty. In 1980, he established Bob Bolton Real Estate along with his wife Cindy. Mr. Bolton completed his career with Meybohm Real Estate upon his retirement in 2014. He was licensed as a Broker in South Carolina and Georgia. As a member of the National Association of Realtors and the South Carolina Association of Realtors, he served as a Realtors Political Action Committee (RPAC) Trustee, Chairman of several State Committees, and State Director. He also was a member of the North Augusta-Belvedere Board of Realtors where he served as RPAC Chairman, Golf Tournament Chairman, Membership Chairman, Scholarship Chairman, Treasurer, Secretary, Vice President and President and was a member of the Augusta/North Augusta MLS where he served as Director, Secretary, Vice-President, and President. Mr. Bolton received many awards during his real estate career including Salesperson of the Month, which he received numerous times for both the local Board and Meybohm Realtors, Life Million Dollar Club Member, Meybohm Real Estate President's Club, Salesperson of the Year, Best of the Best Realtor, and Realtor of the Year.

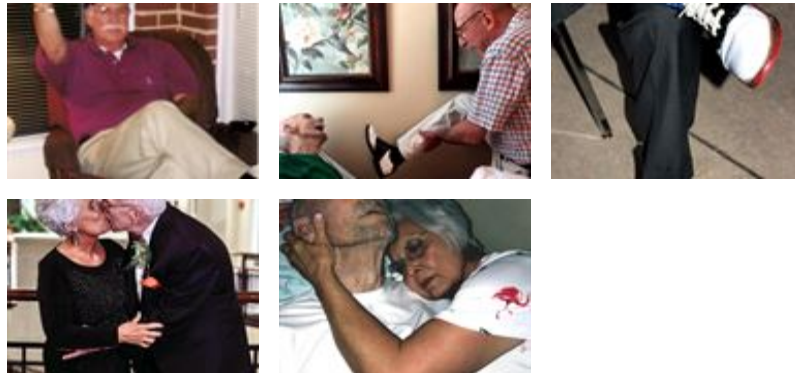
