



## Jack E. Grant Jr.

Augusta, GA—Graveside Services for Mr. Jack E. Grant, Jr., 76, who entered into rest September 5, 2021, will be conducted Friday morning at 10 o'clock in Pineview Memorial Gardens with Veterans Honors and Masonic Rites accorded. Rev. Steve Hartman and Pastor Paul Morris officiating.

Mr. Grant was a life-long resident of Augusta and member of Kiokee Baptist Church. He was a proud Marine Corps Veteran of Vietnam and retired as an Investigator at Georgia. In total he worked in law enforcement for 39 years. Following his retirement, Mr. Grant served as a reserve deputy with the Columbia County Sheriff's Department and the Grovetown Department of Public Safety. Mr. Grant was also a 32nd degree Mason and member of the Martinez Masonic Lodge #710 F.&A.M.

Survivors include two sons, Gregg (Kim) Grant, Lincolnton, GA and John (April) Grant, Harlem, GA; five grandchildren, Brandon Grant, Caleb Grant, Philip Grant, Sarah Grant and Rachel Grant; three sisters, Shirley Cozart, Angell Poston and Marie Mathis, all of North Augusta; one brother Charles Grant, North Augusta.
