



James W. "Jim" Harris

North Augusta, SC—Graveside Services for Mr. James W. “Jim” Harris, 88, who entered into rest November 22, 2018 will be conducted Sunday afternoon at 3 o’clock in Pineview Memorial Gardens with Full Military Honors. Dr. T. Joseph Lusk officiating. The family will receive at the funeral home Sunday afternoon from 1:30 until 2:30.

Mr. Harris was born in Wilmington, North Carolina, on June 23, 1930, and attended New Hanover High School prior to enlisting in the U.S. Army. Before being deployed to Vietnam in 1968 he moved the family to North Augusta to be near his wife’s family. Upon returning from his deployment he retired from the U.S. Army at Ft. Gordan, Georgia with over 22 years of service and settled in North Augusta. During his time in the Army, he served in the Korean Conflict and the Vietnam War; where he was awarded two Bronze stars for valor, two Air Medals, two Commendation medals, the Combat Infantry Badge, and several other commendations and medals. After the military Mr. Harris went on and worked for several companies as a maintenance mechanic, only to retire a second time from the Sweetheart Cup Company. Mr. Harris was a member of Grace United Methodist Church, a life member of the Belvedere Masonic Lodge#388 AFM, Past Worthy Patron of the Belvedere Order of the Eastern Star, member of The Jesse C. Lynch Memorial American Legion Post #71, the 26 Infantry (Blue) Association and the 504 Military Police Association. He was preceded in death by his wife, Billie A. Harris, of North

Augusta, South Carolina, his parents, John W. Harris and Eunice Harris Gibson of Wilmington, North Carolina and his sister, Doris Harris Smith, of Virginia Beach, Virginia.

Survivors include two sons James W. Harris, Jr. (Nancy) Lexington, SC and Glenn W. Harris (Lisa), North Augusta, SC; four grandchildren, Jessica H. Potts (Chip), Lexington, SC, Jon M. Harris (Valerie), Greenville, SC, Summer H. Williams (Evan), Fort Leavenworth, KS and Glenn W. "Will" Harris, Jr. (Southern), North Augusta, SC; two great-grandchildren, Sierra J. Williams, Fort Leavenworth, KS and Abigail J. Harris of Greenville, SC; a sister, Catherine Smith, Wilmington, NC.

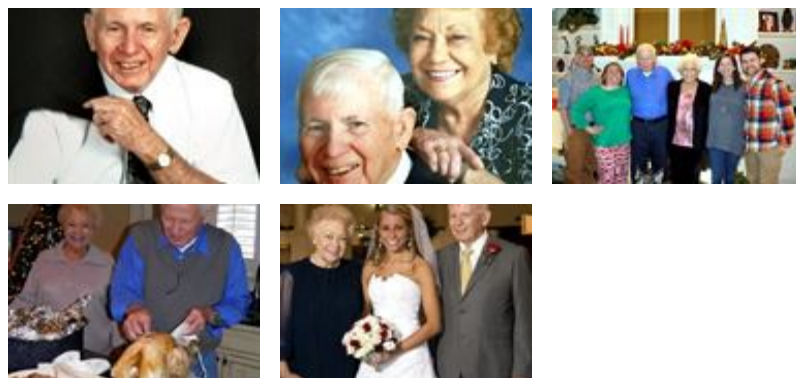
