North Augusta, SC—Funeral Services for Mr. James M. Logan, 81, who entered into rest March 5, 2016, will be conducted Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock from Immanuel Baptist Church. Rev. Jimmy Coyle and Rev. Matthew Love officiating. Interment in Hillcrest Memorial Park.

Mr. Logan was a native of Banks County, Georgia, having made North Augusta his home for the past 65 years. He was a member of Immanuel Baptist Church and the Disciples Sunday School Class. Mr. Logan was a US Army Veteran and a retired bus driver with Columbia County Public Transportation. He was a member of the Jesse C. Lynch Memorial American Legion Post #71, served as custodian of Immanuel Baptist Church for 22 years and was the 2015 recipient of church worker of the year. Perhaps Mr. Logan's greatest accomplishment was his 1980 graduation from Hebron Colony Ministries. Since that time he personally helped over 400 individuals overcome their alcohol and drug addictions. Mr. Logan served as president of Hebron Colony Augusta Support Group since 1980. He was preceded in death by his wife, Nina Dorsett Logan, his parents John and Easter Logan and brother, John Gordon Logan.

Survivors include a son and daughter-in-law, James and Tammy Logan, Augusta, GA; two sisters, Doris Hegler, North Augusta, SC and Betty Davis, Norfolk, VA; two grandchildren, Kurtis Logan and Kaitlyn Logan; several nieces and nephews; and a very special friend, Carlene Williams.

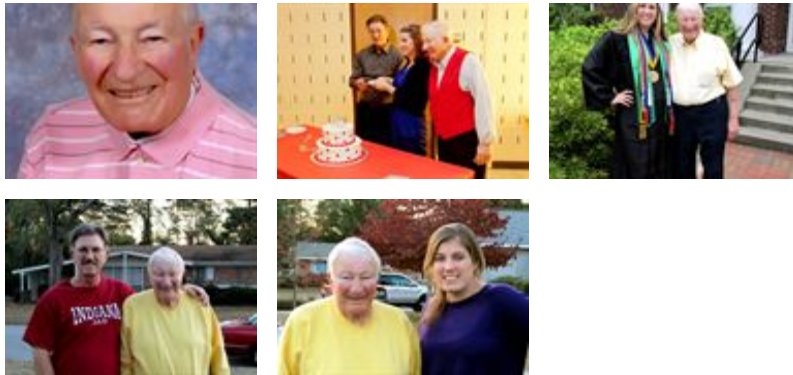
