



## Jane A. Faircloth

July 9, 1947 - January 9, 2016

North Augusta, SC—Mrs. Jane Austin Faircloth, 68, of North Augusta, went to be with her Lord Jesus Christ on January 9, 2015. Funeral services will be held Wednesday morning at 11 o'clock from the First Baptist Church of North Augusta. Dr. Ryan Pack, Rev. Roy Kiser and Dr. Randy Cooper officiating. Interment in Sunset Hill Cemetery.

Originally from Charlotte, Jane lived in North Augusta for the past 48 years. She attended Bowman Gray of Wake Forest University School of Radiography and passed boards to achieve a Registered Technology degree. She later completed her boards with The Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonography (RDMS). Jane retired from University Hospital after 34 years of service. She also volunteered at Augusta Care Pregnancy as their sonographer. Jane was a member of the American Registry of Radiology, American Registry of Diagnostic Medical Sonography & also the Society of Diagnostic Medical Sonography. Jane - as "Nana" - was an adoring grandmother. She wanted to be remembered for her love of Jesus, her love of life, and her love of her grandchildren. As an active member of First Baptist Church of North Augusta, she had a passion for studying and teaching the Bible. The 12th Grade Girls' Sunday School class loved their "Lady Jane." She was often sought out by struggling couples who needed reminding of their love for one another. Her sense of humor poured through her volunteer service at the church and her love for life at Augusta Care Pregnancy Center. Jane loved helping with

sonograms and turning scared moms away from abortion. She was also an avid fan of both the University of North Carolina Basketball & University of Georgia football programs.

Survivors include her husband of 49 years, Cecil E. Faircloth; a daughter, Joy Faircloth Manley (Rusty), Gilbert, SC; two grandchildren, McKenna and David Manley; her mother, Ruby Austin, North August, SC; three sisters, Candy McKenzie, Sardinia, OH, Robin Lund (Bill), Greensboro, NC and Sherrie Deal, Atlanta, GA.
