North Augusta, SC – Memorial Services for Janet Lyman Simon-Heinhold, 81, who entered into rest January 9, 2023, will be conducted Sunday, January 15th afternoon at 3 o'clock from St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church, Father Joseph Shippen officiating. The family will receive friends at the church one hour prior to the service.

Mrs. Heinhold was born February 2, 1941, in Columbia, South Carolina, to the late Osman Prouse Lyman Jr. (Pete) and Mary Ann Wesley Lyman. In addition to her parents, Janet is also preceded in death by her beloved husband and best friend, Charles Ronald Heinhold (Chuck).

Janet grew up in Columbia and graduated from Dreher High School with the class of 1959. She went on to attend Winthrop College (University) and graduated in 1963 with a BS in Elementary Education. She taught school for 33 years, impacting the lives of countless children.
