Belvedere, SC—Funeral Services for Mr. Jeffery Craig Lamar, 72, who entered into rest June 6, 2017, will be conducted Thursday morning at 11 o'clock from the First Baptist Church of North Augusta. Dr. Randy Cooper officiating. Interment in Sunset Hill Cemetery.

Mr. Lamar was a life-long resident of Belvedere and a 1962 graduate of North Augusta High School. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of North Augusta where he served as a deacon and former Sunday School teacher. Mr. Lamar was a US Air Force Veteran of Vietnam having received a Purple Heart and member of the Jesse C. Lynch Memorial American Legion Post #71. He loved all things North Augusta and was a member of "Cally's Great Eight" and the 1961 North Augusta High School Championship Football Team. Mr. Lamar retired from Industrial Sales and currently worked during visiting hours at Posey Funeral Directors. He always had a kind word of encouragement for those he met.

“ Dear Ann, Brannon, Derrick and family,
Craig and I became friends probably 30 years ago when he was a sales rep. coming to Orangeburg, S. C. to make sales calls and contacts. I was over buildings and grounds at the technical college here in Orangeburg at that time. Craig and I immediately bonded not only on the professional side but as friends as well. He would always come to Orangeburg about twice a month, always on Wed. and he would get here early enough for us to discuss products and place an order, then we would just catch up about our families and always end up at the House of Pizza eating lunch. We both shared so much about our faith, family and just good old friendship I think one of us would just take a breath and the other would take that opportunity to jump in with an ongoing conversation. Craig was always so proud of his family as I was mine and he would talk about his love for Ann and "The Boy's" as he called you (Brannon and Derrick) then. He shared about his teaching the youth at church and how much he enjoyed that and truly felt that God had called him for that purpose because he would bond with the youth. Craig and I continued to stay in touch either by phone, email, text and I do not believe a time went by that we did not say how much our friendship meant to each one of us. We would even say "our friendship did not happen by accident - that was a God thing". We would usually end our conversations by saying "I love you brother, man, my friend, or my brother in Christ". After Craig left the company as the sales rep., he would still make it to Orangeburg maybe every couple of months and we always ate at House of Pizza and would bring each other up to date with our families and would always end our visit with a big bear hug and say to each other "I love you brother". Craig came over several months ago and pulled in my drive way in a convertible. He was so excited to tell me Ann had gotten it for him and how much he loved it. Once again, we went to House of Pizza and brought each other up to date with our families. Craig was so excited when those grand's came along and would always tell me how much he loved picking them up from school / daycare. They were truly his pride and joy. I texted Craig on July 4th this year (2017) and said "Happy 4th my friend". I knew it

was unusual for him not to respond pretty quickly but I thought maybe he was just busy or possibly the family had take a trip to the beach for I think the usual annual vacation. Only July 6th I followed up with another text with no response. Today, July 7, I called his cell and it was disconnected - I think when that message came on my heart dropped and I had a feeling something had happened. I knew he was working for Posey Funeral home for visitation and I often told Craig I could not imagine anyone any better as a greater at a door for something like this.

Craig always had a smile, encouraging words and positive no matter what was going on.

I pulled up the funeral home and saw Craig's name in the obituary. My heart sank and I began sobbing. I could not believe my dear friend had passed away and I did not get to tell him good bye and I love you brother. I am still just in disbelief that I will not see him again on this side of Heaven but I have no doubt when God reached for Craig's hand He said "Well done my good and faithful servant"! Well done indeed my friend and brother in Christ. Praise God for giving me the great pleasure of knowing and having you as my friend. Ann, please know I am praying for you, the boys and all the family. I can only begin to imagine the great void that has been left in your lives as I feel the void in my life for not having that one last time to say goodbye. Craig, I love you man and you have left a hug legacy and one that I will inspire to follow so we can meet again as we continue our friendship in our eternal home honoring and praising God for His blessings.
