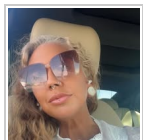
As were her wishes her ashes will be interned with a flowering tree and planted in her honor. Family and friends are welcome to share loving memories and prayer as we honor her wishes.

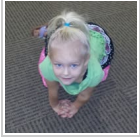
