“ I was so saddened to hear the news of Jerry's passing. I have many happy memories with Jerry when we were growing up together, along with his brother, Arnold, sister Yvonne, and my sister, Adele. We were known as the Barnyard Gang or Gang of Five. We were more like brothers and sisters than first cousins.

We walked from Pinoak to Matoaka to the movies. It was during WWII and news reels of the war showed the airplanes and ships in combat. It was the real deal. In Grandpa's and Grandmother's big house, we'd sit around the table in the long dining room and play card games...usually Set Back. We walked to Tub Hill's store at Lashmeet and take a short cut across the big sawdust pile from the sawmill there. The sawdust was hot on our feet when we would go barefoot. We hopped fast through it. We sometimes walked to Pinoak Grade School together. The warm pond in Grandpa's field was so inviting while we dodged tadpoles. We cut out our own Christmas trees from the woods and put it up in the living room just across from the dining room in Grandpa's big house that burned in December 1950.

There are just too many memories to document here but our parents and grandparents had great love for us all.

Jerry was very knowledgeable and full of humor to keep us entertained. He sang songs for us. One was Jack O' Diamonds by Burl Ives and another one was Life Gets Tedious, Don't It. Jerry had a heart of gold and was a wonderful father to his children and had a great love for his wife, Anne Marie, and all of his family members.

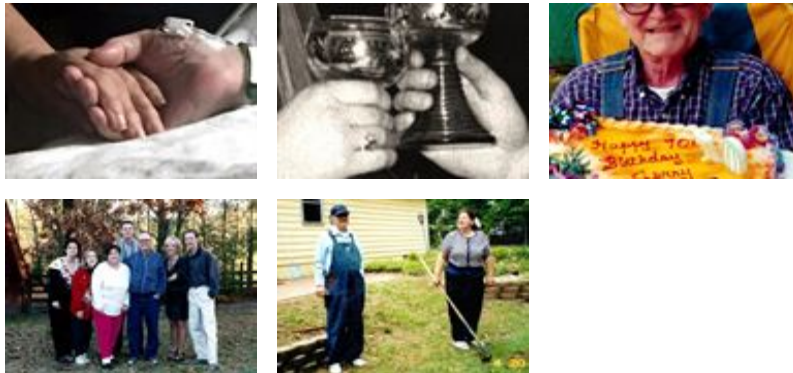

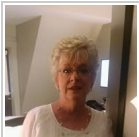
