Mr. Brannon was the founder of Unifab Pipe Fabrication in Jackson, retired as a Pipefitter with the E. I. DuPont Company at the Savannah River Site was a former Magistrate in Jackson, a Shriner and a member of the Hopewell Masonic Lodge for over 30 years. He was a long-time supporter of Jackson Youth Baseball where he sponsored the "Brannon Boys" baseball team. Mr. Brannon was preceded in death by his first wife, Mrs. Jewel Brannon.
