Mr. Smith was born in Augusta, Georgia, on March 8, 1927, to the late Benjamin Roy and Ella Belle Scurry Smith. He graduated from The Academy of Richmond County in 1944 and from The Junior College of Augusta in 1946. He was a U. S. Merchant Marine and then graduated from Bob Jones University in 1949. He worked at McKie Hunt Motor Company until 1956 when he started Southeastern Equipment Company, Inc., which was later named SECO Parts and Equipment.
