North Augusta, SC – Funeral Services for Joseph Herman Weil, Jr., 82, who entered into rest September 15, 2023, will be conducted Monday morning at 10 o'clock from the Posey Funeral Chapel, Rev. Ashley Buchanan officiating. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service. Graveside Services will be held Tuesday at 12 noon at Mt. Mr. Weil was born March 11, 1941, in Tupelo, MS to the late Joseph and Angie Weil. He was a graduate of Tupelo High School and Itawamba Community College. Mr. Weil earned his bachelor's degree in math and social studies and Master of Education in school administration from Mississippi State University as well as a sixth-year specialist degree in school administration from the University of Georgia. He taught math in Cobb and Rockdale counties in Georgia, serving as an elementary school teacher in Rockdale County, Georgia. Mr. Weil was the Principal at J.H. House Elementary School in Conyers, GA for 22 years. He was a member of Grace United Methodist Church and the Stillwell Sunday School Class. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Linda Celestia Raulerson Weil; siblings, Robert Weil, William T. Weil, JoAnn Duncan and Jeanette Moore.
