North Augusta, SC—Funeral services for Mr. Joseph A. Britt, Sr. 79, of Timberidge Drive, North Augusta, SC, who entered into rest July 27, 2010 will be conducted Saturday morning at 10 o'clock from the Belvedere First Baptist Church. Rev. Mr. Britt was a native of Alma, GA, having made North Augusta his home for the past 57 years. He was a U.S. Army Veteran of the Korean Conflict, retired from E.I. DuPont at the Savannah River Site with 38 years and Westinghouse with 4 years of service. Mr. Britt was active in coaching Little League football and baseball and was an Assistant Football Coach at Paul Knox Middle School. He was a Life Member of the Acacia Masonic Lodge #315 AFM, and a member of Belvedere First Baptist Church where he served as a Sunday School Teacher, Deacon and on various Church Committees.

Survivors include his wife of 56 years, Waunell Carter Britt; a son and daughter-in-law, Joe and Cindy Britt, Jr., North Augusta; a daughter and son-in-law, Patti and Dan Jenrich, Charlotte, NC; two grandchildren, Cameron Jenrich, Washington, DC and Britt Mickey, Charlotte, NC; two brothers, Buddy Jack Britt, Jacksonville, FL and Johnny Mac Britt, Dearborn, MI; two sisters, Yvonne Newberry and Linda Ivey, both of Alma, GA.
