Beech Island, SC – Funeral services for Mr. Kenneth Robert Golden, Sr., 77, entered into rest March 28, 2026, will be conducted Wednesday morning, April 1st, at 11 o'clock in the Historic First Baptist Church of Beech Island. Rev. Greg Williams, Rev. Frank Barker and Rev. Andy Menger officiating. Interment will follow in the Historic First Baptist Church of Beech Island Cemetery; veteran's honors will be rendered by the United States Navy and the Jesse C. Lynch American Legion Post 71. The family will receive friends at the funeral home, Tuesday, March 31st from 5 until 7 o'clock.

Kenneth was a lifelong resident of Beech Island, SC and learned to farm as teenager where he gained the knowledge about tractors that earned him a spot in the Navy Seabees as a heavy equipment operator. He was a proud Vietnam Veteran.

He began a career in power plant operations with SCE&G at the Urquhart Plant in Beech Island, SC. Kenneth retired after 37 years to spend more time being a papa to his grandchildren. He was a devoted Christian and a member of the Historic First Baptist Church of Beech Island, and he loved his church like his family.

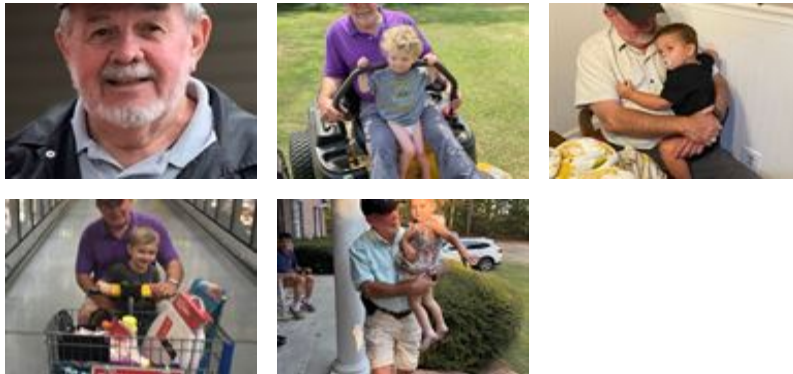

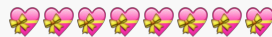
