North Augusta, SC—Memorial Services for Mr. Khoi Van Vo, 67, who entered into rest May 23, 2026, will be conducted Tuesday, June 2, 2026, at 11 o'clock in St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church. Mr. Vo was native of Danang, Vietnam, having made North Augusta his home for the past 36 years. He came to the United States at the age of 16 and worked very hard to put himself through high school and college including working as a dishwasher and busboy and construction. With much hard work and sacrifice Mr. Vo earned his degree in mechanical engineering from the University of North Carolina at Charlotte. He worked at the Savannah River site as an engineer for 25 years before retiring. Mr. Vo was an active parishioner of St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church where he cherished his church community. He enjoyed traveling, playing sudoku, listening to music, watching college basketball and soccer and eating good food. He was a very generous person who greatly loved his family and friends.

Survivors include his loving wife of 35 years, Zenaida Vo; four brothers, Chan Van Vo, Nhuan Van Vo, Dac Van Vo and Tai Van Vo; four sisters, Bich Tran, Xuan Thi Thanh Vo, Hoa Thi Vo and Hoa Thi Le Vo. He was also a loving uncle to numerous nieces and nephews.
