North Augusta, SC – Celebration of Life Services for Deacon King David Curry, 72, who entered into rest February 18, 2022, at Doctors Hospital, Martinez, GA, will be conducted Wednesday afternoon at 1 o'clock in the Posey Funeral Chapel. He graduated from Jobs Corp of America with a certification in Carpentry and later earned a certification as an Electrician. David was employed by Parksdale Textile Plant and retired as an Electrician after forty years of service. Following his retirement, he served three years with the Aiken County School System as a school bus driver. In his spare time, he enjoyed working in his workshop and fishing. David was married fifty-two years to his loving wife, Josephine Young-Curry. Through their union they were blessed with four children. He was converted and baptized at the Mims Grove Baptist Church under the pastorage of Reverend Thomas Scott. David served in the capacity of deacon, trustee and sang in the church choir.
