Kyle was born December 5, 1985, in Augusta, GA and was raised in North Augusta, SC. He attended Furman University, where he received his undergraduate degree in Chemistry and then attended East Carolina University, where he received his master's degree in nuclear physics. Kyle worked at the Defense Threat Reduction Agency, Los Alamos National Labs as a scientist and Nuclear Command and Control Engineer to the United States Military. He was an avid outdoors man and enjoyed hiking and hunting. Kyle loved his family and will be missed by all who knew him.
