



Lamega Sharpe "Mickey" Bush

Augusta, GA – Funeral Services for Mrs. Lamega Sharpe “Mickey” Bush, 89, who entered into rest March 4, 2024, will be conducted Saturday afternoon, March 9th, at 2 o’clock from Asbury United Methodist Church with Pastor Thom Davies officiating. Interment will follow in Pineview Memorial Gardens. The family will receive friends at the church one hour prior to the service from 1 until 2 o’clock.

Mrs. Bush was born July 4, 1934, and was a lifelong resident of Augusta, GA. She retired as a Licensed Practical Nurse with 35 years of service in the University Hospital System.
