North Augusta, SC – Funeral Services for Mrs. Laura Ann Towner, 85, who entered into rest May 22, 2022, will be conducted Thursday morning at 10 o'clock at Sweetwater Baptist Church. Dr. Paul W. Noe and Dr. Roy L. Head officiating. Interment will follow in Westover Memorial Park. The family will receive friends at the funeral home Wednesday evening from 6 until 8 o'clock.

Mrs. Towner was born April 12, 1937, to the late William Bluford Chambley, Jr. and Agnes Hanners Chambley. She was a native of Columbus, GA, a former resident of Kings Mountain, NC and Augusta, GA, having made North Augusta, SC her home for the past 55 years. Mrs. Towner was a former member of Crawford Avenue Baptist Church and a longtime member of Belvedere First Baptist Church, where she was a member of the Frank Buck Sunday School Class. She lived her life serving others and often volunteered her time in the community, working with Belvedere Elementary School with their Good News Club and teaching at the Augusta Reading Foundation. Professionally, she served as VP of Consumer Loans at Bankers First and retired with 25 years of service. Mrs. Towner will be fondly remembered as a strong, Christian woman who loved her family and adored her grandchildren. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by a brother, William B. Chambley, III.

Survivors include her husband of 67 years, Ernest Towner; two sons, Timothy

Towner (Linda) and Stacey Towner (Holley) all of North Augusta, SC; six grandchildren, Andrea Osborne (Matt), Ashlyn Towner, Jordan Towner (Alex), Aaron Towner, Andrew Towner and Adam Towner; one great-grandson, Luke Osborne; three brothers, Phil Chambley (Hannah) of Rome, GA, John Chambley (Leigh Ann) of Evans, GA, and James Chambley of Augusta, GA.

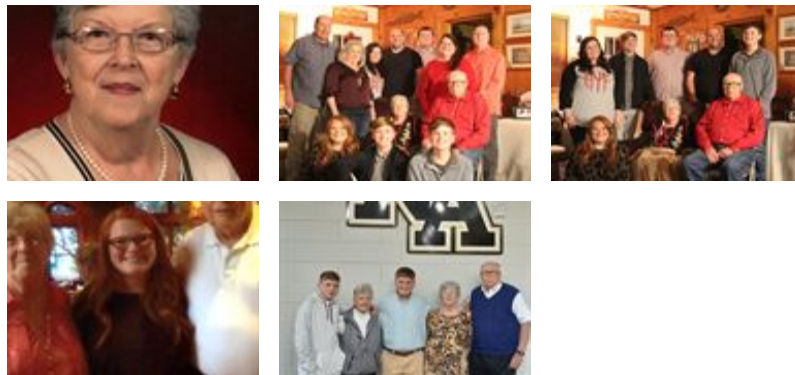
