



## Leila Mae Hoehn

May 24, 1924 - August 11, 2022

North Augusta, SC – The Memorial Service for Mrs. Leila Mae Hoehn, 98, who entered into eternal rest August 11, 2022, will be conducted Saturday morning, September 24, 2022, at 10 o'clock in the Posey Funeral Chapel. Leila was born May 24, 1924, to the late Wiley Thomas Huffman and Lillie May Sweeney Huffman. She was raised in Augusta, GA, and was a founding parishioner of Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church. Leila was devout in her faith and a true Christian woman in every way. She was recognized by Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church as Catholic Woman of the Year in 1980. As a young woman she met her sweetheart, Robert Glen Hoehn, and they married on January 12, 1943, prior to his deployment during World War II. Leila faithfully supported her husband throughout his career in the U.S. Army and was a dedicated mother to their six children. Her love for her family was unconditional and she sought every opportunity to support them however she could. One of Leila's fondest joys was teaching with her great friend, Celeste Spence, who founded the Walden Hall Christian Montessori School in North Augusta. She was known for her positive approach to life and was always willing to offer a smile, a laugh, and words of encouragement. Leila would often sit and swing on her front porch and enjoy the beauty of her home and

the outdoors, offering a simple wave and smile to all who passed her home.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Robert Glen Hoehn, Sr.; a son, Robert G. "Bobby" Hoehn, Jr.; a great-grandchild, Cody Jack Arend; and nine siblings.

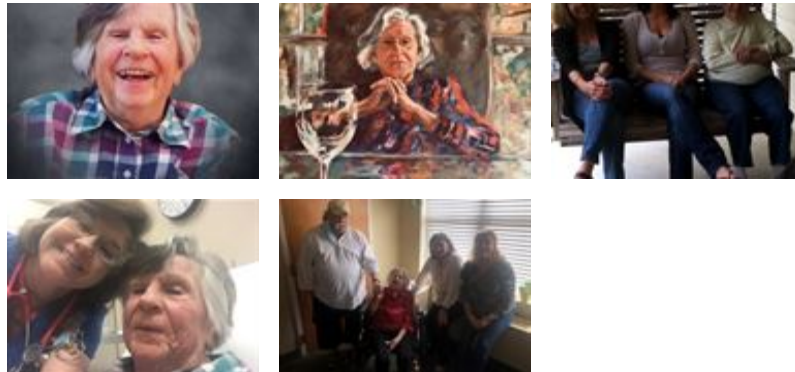
