North Augusta, SC—Funeral Services for Mr. Leland Ray Moore, 79, of Winyah Drive, North Augusta, SC, who entered into rest at University Hospital Heart and Vascular Center on his 51st wedding anniversary, May 16, 2010, will be conducted Wednesday afternoon at 3 o'clock from the First Baptist Church of North Augusta. Mr. Moore was a native of Lancaster, SC, having made North Augusta his home for the past 44 years. He attained the rank of Eagle Scout at the age of 17, was a U.S. Army Veteran of the Korean Conflict and a member of the Jesse C. Lynch Memorial American Legion Post # 71. Mr. Moore retired from Swift and Company as a Beef Product Manager with 33 years of service. He was a volunteer at the North Augusta Recreation Center and was the 2009 North Augusta Volunteer of the Year award recipient. Mr. Moore was known for his sense of humor, kindness and positive attitude. He was a member of First Baptist Church of North Augusta. Mr. Moore was preceded in death by his parents, Julian and Etta Moore and a brother, Cecil Moore.
