Mr. Lester R. Lane

North Augusta, SC— Funeral Services for Mr. Lester R. Lane, 50, who entered into rest, December 19, 2016, will be conducted Wednesday morning at 10 o'clock from the Posey Funeral Chapel. Interment will follow in Fort Jackson National Cemetery at 2 o'clock with Full Military Honors.

Mr. Lane was a native of Hico, TX, having made North Augusta his home for the past seven years. He was of the Baptist faith and a retired U.S. Army veteran with 24 years of service. During his service he deployed to Iraq, Kosovo and other assignments. Mr. Lane conclude his military service as a recruiter, later serving as Recruiting Station Commander. He was a member of the American Legion Jessie C. Lynch Memorial Post 71, the American Legion Riders and the Patriot Guard Riders.
