Linda was born June 29, 1948, to the late Clarence and Maria McPherson. She was raised in North Augusta, SC, having made Ponte Vedra Beach, FL her home for the past 30 years. Linda was a graduate of North Augusta High School and the University of South Carolina, remaining an avid Gamecock fan throughout her life. She excelled in her career as a Registered Nurse and retired with 40 years of service. Linda loved to play tennis and travel around

the world with her beloved husband. They often enjoyed their mountain home in North Carolina and their time spent together at the beach. For the past 25 years Linda courageously battled Parkinson's disease and was a member of Rock Steady Boxing, a nonprofit gym that provides a uniquely effective physical exercise for those living with Parkinson's.

In addition to her parents, Linda was preceded in death by a brother Malcolm McPherson; and a beloved nephew, Wade McPherson. Surviving family members left to cherish her memory include her husband of 53 years, Dan Harless; a daughter, Mandee Lott (Chris) of Woodbine, GA; a son, Jeff Harless (Christie) of Jacksonville, FL; a brother, C.O. McPherson (Stephanie) of Augusta, GA; six grandchildren, Taylor Cook (Josh), Drew Harless, Jacob Harless, Carli Lott, Sara Harless, and Jesse Lott; two great-grandchildren, Phoebe Cook and Braelin Crews; a host of nieces and nephews, including a special nephew, Chad McPherson (Beth).

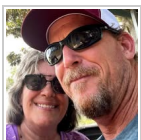
