North Augusta, SC- Funeral Services of Linda Louise Johnson, 85, who entered into rest June 1, 2025, will be conducted Friday morning at 11 o'clock from the Posey Funeral Chapel. Rev. Ms. Linda was born September 19, 1939, to the late Clarence Oscar Johnson, Sr. and Bertha Cook Johnson in Augusta, GA. She received her nursing degree from South Carolina Baptist Nursing School and later furthered her education at Florida State University where she received her B.A. in Nursing. Ms. Linda then received her master's from Emory University. She was the Chief Nurse for the State of Georgia for over 25 years in the public health care system and supervised over 80 nurses in the state. Ms. Linda was a member of the First Baptist Church of North Augusta and was a member of the choir. She worked with Project Hope in Arizona helping the native tribes. Ms. Linda was a friend to many and will be greatly missed by all who knew her. In addition to her parents, she is preceded in death by her sister-in-law, Laura Johnson.

Surviving members of the family left to cherish her memory include her brothers, Clarence Oscar "C.O." Johnson, Jr. and Sidney Cook (Pamela) Johnson and several nephews and nieces.
