Pierre Robert Chapter National Society Colonial Dames Seventeen Century Augusta Chapter, National Society Daughters of the American Revolution, First Families of South Carolina, Sons and Daughters of the Colonial Antebellum Bench and Bar, George Walton Chapter of the National Society Daughters of the American Colonists. She was also a member of many other lineage organizations including the Augusta Treaty Chapter of the Continental Society Daughters of Indian Wars, National Society Sons and Daughters of Antebellum Planters, National Society of Founders and Patriots, Georgia Division of the Magna Charta Dames, and National Society Daughters of Colonial Wars.

Mrs. Pietrowski was preceded in death by two husbands, Harold Hamlet and Edward Lewis Pietrowski.

Survivors include three nieces, Sally M. Smith, Easley, SC, Emily M. Hackle (Robert), Easley, SC and Lisa P. Hicks, Dyersburg, TN; three nephews, James W. 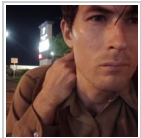
