Throughout her life, she dedicated countless hours to volunteer work including the Junior League, Hospital Volunteer, Altar Guild, Sunday School Teacher, Cursillo Movement, Stephen Ministry and a special love, the Church Choir.

Mrs. Charnock has been a vibrant and faithful servant in the Franciscan family, a spiritual family raised up by the Holy Spirit in the Catholic Church. In 1993, she recognized that the Holy Spirit was calling her to follow Christ in the footsteps of Saint Francis of Assisi. She entered the Secular Franciscan Order in Augusta within St. Elizabeth of Hungary Fraternity. While living this way of life, she served in several executive capacities within her local fraternity and regional fraternity. Mrs. Charnock was preceded in death by her husband, Maurice P. Charnock, Sr. and grandson, Roger Charnock.
