North Augusta, SC—The Mass of Christian Burial for Mr. Lucius L. Bultman, Sr., 84, of Highview Avenue, North Augusta, SC, who entered into rest December 17, 2013, will be conducted Saturday morning at 11 o'clock from Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church. Mr. Bultman was a native of Columbia, SC, having made North Augusta his home for the past 55 years.
