He grew up as a member of Belvedere First Baptist Church, where he enjoyed serving with the church's security team and has recently attended First Baptist Church of Vacluse. Luke was employed as a computer programmer with Savannah River Nuclear Solutions. Prior to his employment at the Savannah River Site, he worked with the Wilson Family YMCA of Augusta. During his time there, Luke found great joy as an instructor, teaching swim lessons, CPR classes and lifeguarding. He had a great, self-driven, work ethic in his approach to life and his service to others. Luke was a profound Christian who will be fondly remembered for having a servant's heart and constantly putting others first. He always sought out

opportunities to serve, offering his selfless love and service to everyone he met. As a youth, Luke loved music, especially Christian music and playing in the youth band at Belvedere First Baptist Church. He also learned to play drums so he would have an opportunity to play in church on Sunday mornings. Luke had a special place in his heart for helping children and youth even after graduating from the church youth program. He also enjoyed playing video games which ultimately led him into his career as a computer programmer.

Survivors include his parents, David and Annette Fetterhoff; two brothers, Joshua Fetterhoff and Curtis Fetterhoff; and the love of his life, Erin Greene.

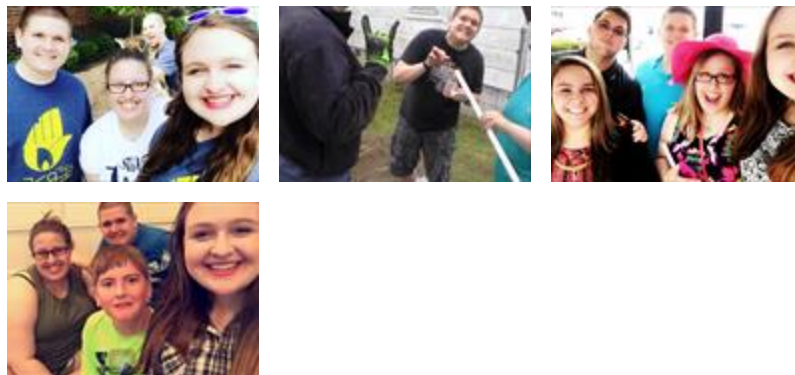
