May 12, 1950 - May 1, 2021

On Saturday, May 1, 2021 Lynn Ellen Bryant Stembridge entered into eternal rest at her home after a brief battle with colon cancer. She was surrounded by her faithful husband of 52 years, Gary Stembridge, and dear friends, Donna and Roger Jones. She was born May 12, 1950 to Hub and Nade Bryant, both deceased, of Dade City, Florida. North Augusta, SC was her home of 40 years after she traveled the world as an Army wife. She retired from Aiken County after 33 years of service as an employee of the Office of Voter Registration and the RMC office and served her community of North Augusta on the Board of Zoning Appeals. At the time of her retirement, she was the office manager and Deputy RMC Clerk in the RMC for Aiken County. As a gifted seamstress, she sewed for anyone who needed a helping hand. She was happiest in her camper traveling with her husband and family. The beach at Tybee Island was her favorite place to visit and will be her final resting place. The Pink Magnolias of Augusta, GA held a special place in her heart as a breast cancer survivor.

Mother was her favorite title and she raised two wonderful men. She is survived by her sons, Timothy (Crystal) Stembridge and Jeff (Amy) Stembridge. She was the beloved GiGi to Easton and Ayden Stembridge both of North Augusta. Davis, Jackson, and Amelia Stembridge of Bamberg, SC also loved their Grandma Lynn very much. 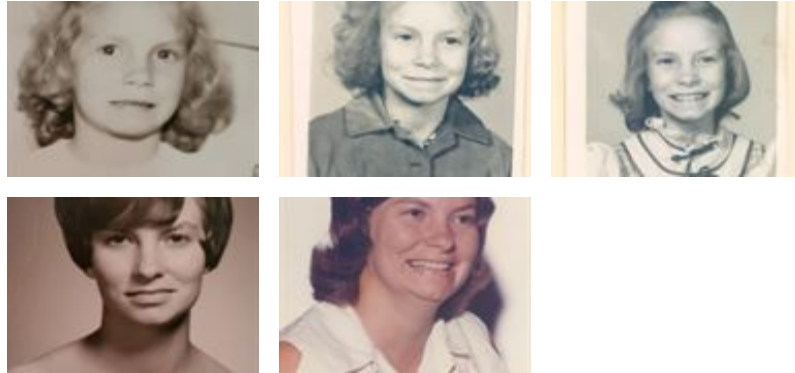
