January 17, 1943 - July 14, 2024

North Augusta, SC – Funeral Services for Mrs. Anne Fulghum, 81, who entered into rest July 14, 2024, will be conducted Thursday morning at 10 o'clock from the Posey Funeral Chapel with Rev. Dave Vosseller officiating. Interment will follow in Sunset Hill Cemetery. The family will receive friends at the funeral home Wednesday evening from 6 until 8 o'clock.

Anne was born January 17, 1943, to the late Earl Woodrow Blevins, Sr. and Vivian Hellmuth Blevins. Anne was raised in North Augusta and attended North Augusta High School before marrying her sweetheart, the late Capt. Joseph T. Fulghum. Following their marriage, Anne faithfully supported her family and her husband throughout his extensive military career in the U.S. Air Force. His military service took their family from Florida, to Montana, to Alaska, and eventually settled back in North Augusta. Anne graduated from Great Falls College in Montana and later received her master's degree from Augusta College. She enjoyed a fulfilling career as an English teacher and retired from North Augusta High School with 20 years of service. Anne loved teaching and mentoring her students. Imparting her knowledge to them was a great passion of hers. She enjoyed crafting, quilting, gardening, and was known for her green thumb. Anne's greatest joy in life was her family, with traveling and family cruises being some of her fondest memories.

In addition to her husband and parents, Anne was preceded in death by her

brother, Earl W. Blevins, Jr.

Surviving family members left to cherish her memory include her children, Penny Miller (Terry) and Joe Fulghum (Toni); her grandchildren, Wesley Fulghum (Hyunhee) and Carrie Anne Fulghum (Alex Tate); and her great-grandchild, Violet Fulghum.
