Belvedere, SC—Funeral Services for Rev. M. Wesley Gregory, Jr., 86, who entered into rest September 3, 2013, will be conducted Thursday morning at 11 o'clock from the Belvedere First Baptist Church. Rev. Gregory was a native of Union, South Carolina, having made Belvedere his home for the past 62 years. He was a member of Belvedere First Baptist Church and a former charter member of Bel-Ridge Baptist Church. Rev. Gregory was a U.S. Army Veteran of WWII, where he served in the European Theater, and retired as a Patrol Officer from DuPont in 1984. For 46 years, Rev. Gregory also served as a Bi-vocational Baptist Minister, pastoring Good Hope, Ridgeview and Clearwater Branch Baptist Churches. Throughout his ministry, Rev. Gregory was blessed to speak in 50 churches; some as a regular pastor, others during revivals or as interim pastor. He was preceded in death by his wife, Mrs. Ruth Beach Gregory and two grandsons, Jeremy Gregory Grimes and David Blackstock.

Survivors include three daughters and sons-in-law, Mary Ruth and Terry Blackstock, Clayton, GA, Patricia and William Fulmer, North Augusta, SC and Kathy Gregory, North Augusta, SC; four grandchildren, Jonathan Blackstock, Jennifer Phillips, Samantha Grimes and Tabitha Grimes; five great-grandchildren.
