Mrs. Callicott was a life-long resident of North Augusta and a member of Grace United Methodist Church. She was the only child of Paul Austin Diendorf and Allie Irene McCann. Recently, while living with her daughter, she attended the Hill Baptist Church. Mrs. Callicott's career was spent teaching children. She was Director of Grace United Methodist Church Kindergarten for 13 years, she worked at the Child Care Center at University Hospital and finished her career as the Head Teacher at the Augusta College Child Development Center. Mrs. Callicott was a charter member of the CSR Pre-School Association, the South Carolina Association on Children under Six and the Association for Childhood Education International. She was also a member of the North Augusta Women's Club, where she served as treasurer and vice president and also served on the Volunteer Board of University Health Care. In 1999, she received a service pen in honor of her 2,500 hours of volunteer service to University. Mrs. Callicott was preceded in death by her husband, Calloway Moisant Callicott, Sr., and son, Calloway Moisant Callicott, Jr.

Survivors include three daughters, Ann C. Stalnaker (Ed), Augusta, GA, Margaret C. Gilleland (Dwight), Dawsonville, GA and Bonnie C.
