Mr. Farr was a native and former resident of Augusta, having made Jackson his home for the past 16 years. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Jackson, the Barraca II Sunday School Class, the Augusta Better Government Committee and a US Army Veteran. Mr. Farr was a 32nd Degree Scottish Rite Mason, a 50 year member of the George Walton Masonic Lodge #699 F & A M , a member of the Alee Temple and the Alice Warren Chapter#483 OES. He was a former Fireman with the City of Augusta and was the Director of Inspections with Augusta-Richmond County, retiring with 45 years of service. Mr. Farr was an avid golfer and a member of the Green Meadows Country Club and the "Irish Mofia". He was preceded in death by his parents, Mike and Molly Norris Farr and his sister, Evelyn Martin.

Survivors include his wife of 52 years, Jo Ann Reeder Farr; a daughter, Kimberley Kaye Farr, North Augusta; several nieces and nephews.
