Private Funeral Services for Mrs. Mary Anne Garrett Park, 69, who entered into rest August 26, 2020, will be held in the Posey Funeral Chapel with The Reverend Canon Hartley officiating. The public is invited to view the livestreamed service, Monday morning at 11 o'clock on the Posey Funeral Directors Facebook page.

Mrs. Park was a lifelong resident of North Augusta, SC and had a long career at Augusta University Medical Center. She served as the director of organ procurement for many years and recently retired as the manager of clinical research, with over 26 years of service. Mrs. Park was an active member of St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church, where she served in multiple positions, both the church and the diocese. She was preceded in death by her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Jack Garrett, Sr.; and a brother, Jack Garrett, Jr.

Survivors include her husband of 27 years, Ron Park; and her son, David Park.

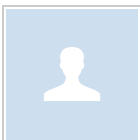
