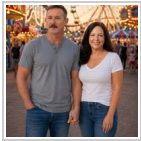

I was a rough kid & teen to handle - wasn't always easy, but you were always patient with me.

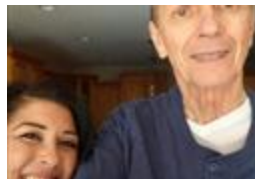
You continued to care for me-even when I became an adult and moved out.
