Michael “Mike” John Perron, 64, passed in his home surrounded by his loving children on Saturday, January 25th, 2020, after a brave, yet brief battle with Pancreatic cancer.

Michael was born on June 15, 1955 in Farmington, Maine. He spent his childhood years in Jay, Maine with his 5 siblings wreaking havoc on his neighborhood with his cousin, Jimmy Richards and close buddy, Mike Fournier.
