



Mimmo Guerrieri

May 14, 1937 - September 2, 2022

Wagener, SC – Memorial Services for Mr. Domenico Carlo Luigi “Mimmo” Guerrieri, 85, who entered into rest September 2, 2022, will be announced at a later date.

Mimmo was born May 14, 1937, to the late Ariodante Guerrieri and Emilia Colapinto Guerrieri. He was born in Acquaviva delle Fonti, Italy and raised in Gioia del Colle, Italy during World War II. He and his family suffered great hardship because of the war but received much needed relief from the American G.I.'s. Due to the overwhelming kindness from the U.S. soldiers, he dreamed of becoming an American citizen. In 1955, as a young adult, he enlisted and served as a Technical Sergeant in the Italian Air Force for seven years. During his service, he was called upon to work with the incoming American military where he met and married his American sweetheart, Jean. In 1962, Mimmo's lifelong wish of entering the United States became a reality and he proudly became a U.S. citizen in 1965.

He was a parishioner of Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church. He began his civilian career as an architectural draftsman, working with several different firms and would later become the head of building maintenance at the Medical College of Georgia for eight years. Mimmo was promoted to the position of Physical Plant Director at Augusta University, and retired with over 20 years of service. He was a skilled craftsman, who enjoyed woodworking, making

furniture and toys, and even built his own home. Mimmo had an affinity for nature, loved the outdoors and had a great appreciation for hard work. He found great peace in listening to classical music. His greatest joy in life was spending time with his whole family, children and grandchildren, gathered around the table spread with traditional homemade favorite dishes. He will be fondly remembered for his fierce loyalty to his family, his love for his county and the freedoms he enjoyed.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a grandson, Joseph Michael Guerrieri; two sisters, Rosaria Micco and Maria Capasso. Surviving family include his devoted wife of 62 years, Jean Guerrieri; four children, Danny (Betty) Guerrieri, Amy (Jay) Taylor, Eddie (Monica) Guerrieri, and Sally (Chip) Weathers-Cochran; a sister, Palma Guerrieri, and extended Italian family; ten grandchildren, Jay Guerrieri, Kristen Taylor, Melissa (Micah) Taylor-Follett, Tres Taylor, Paige (Seth) Wright, Daniel (Francine) Gibbs, Domenic Guerrieri, Caleb Guerrieri, Brianna Weathers, Julianna Weathers and Macy Cochran; three great-grandchildren, Hollymarie, Kaleb and Kinley.
