North Augusta, SC—Funeral services for Mrs. Myrtle Anderson Johnson, 88, formerly of Hammond Place, who entered into rest September 12, 2009, will be conducted Tuesday afternoon at 3 o'clock from the First Baptist Church of North Augusta.
