Nan Scott Harris Barrient, 70, of North Augusta, SC passed away peacefully at her home on January 2, 2019 after a valiant battle with cancer.

Nan was born to Robert G. Harris and Barbara Leckie Atwater on July 1, 1948 in Los Angeles, CA. At a young age, she and her brother Steve moved to Saginaw, Michigan with their mother. Nan's greatest love was her family. She cherished the times she spent with her siblings, daughters and grandchildren. Although she lived quite a distance from her two daughters, they were always close to her heart. For many years, she looked forward to the time that they were able to spend with each other when their families would vacation in California or when they took trips together. The time they spent enjoying Grandma's cooking and swimming in

the backyard will always hold a very special place in the hearts of her grandchildren. Nan was an amazing chef, so much so that she opened a highly successful catering business in Southern California called The Elegant Feast. Her husband reaped the rewards of her culinary talent and looked forward to every meal she made, especially Friday night hor d'oeuvres. Her Thanksgiving feasts she hosted for many years were very special to her family. She also had a love for traveling, probably because of her upbringing. She turned her love of traveling into a career as a travel agent and eventually owned her own travel agency, Boulevard Travel. And finally, family members and friends were keenly aware of Nan's two favorite pastimes, gambling (the excitement of the sound of a casino) and of course, shopping. She thoroughly enjoyed Saturday morning garage sales with Jack and her very successful Ebay business.
