These Adventures some being crazy, a little funny, then some would say I would never go anywhere with Dean and Dean never go anywhere with Linda. But through all of our life as Uncle and Niece we enjoy our life together. I love my Uncle Dean and he loved his Niece Linda Bodie Allen. Dean I long for the day I will see you again.
