Entered into rest on August 13, 2021, Mrs. Nettie Louise Morgan Markwalter, wife of 42 years to the late William Joseph Markwalter.

Louise (Nana) was born in Savannah, GA on February 7, 1924 to Fred Henry Morgan, Sr. and Josie Mae Cartledge Morgan. She grew up in Parksville and McCormick, SC. She graduated from McCormick High School in 1941 and Brenau College Class of 1945. She moved with her family to North Augusta in 1945. She and William Joseph (Bill) Markwalter were the first couple married at the first Catholic Church in North Augusta – Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church (Now Posey’s Funeral Home) on July 5, 1947.

She was an active member of Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church and served as a Eucharistic Minister.

She retired from the Medical College of Georgia in 1984 where she had been employed in the Curriculum office and the Department of Anatomy. She was recognized on stage at an MCG graduation by the students for her exemplary service to them while she was assistant in the Curriculum office.
