Mrs. Benenhaley was a native of Sumter, South Carolina, having made North Augusta her home for the past 39 years. She was a member of the Sweetwater Baptist Church where she served in the Nursery and Choir for 21 years. While living in Sumter she became a Christian and a member of Long Branch Baptist Church. When she met and married Eleazer she did not know he would become a preacher. They moved to Kentucky for her husband to complete his education. While there she attended Clear Creek for a short time, but decided it was more important to stay at home caring for her children. The woman described in Proverbs 31 pictures Nina. As a Pastor's Wife, she always sustained her husband's work and was an example of quiet leadership with devotion to her family. At Dr. Benenhaley's retirement celebration, Dr. Skip Myers commented "Miss Nina, as she was affectionally known, if I were to pick a model for preacher's wives, it would be you." A deacon in Kentucky remarked, "Preacher, the way you preach, if you had a personality like your wife, you could go some place!". Nina can be remembered as a great Christian wife, mother and friend. She was a wonderful homemaker with exceptional skills in cooking and home management. She was predeceased by a son, Clayton Benenhaley.

Survivors include her loving husband of 67 years, Dr. Eleazer Benenhaley; two sons, Wilbur (Cathy) Benenhaley and Tim (Tammy) Benenhaley both of North Augusta; a daughter-in-law, Deborah Benenhaley, Langley; six grandchildren, Alexis Black, Meredith Taylor, Matthew Benenhaley, Breanna Benenhaley, Brooke Benenhaley and Blair Benenhaley; five step-grandchildren, Trevor Loehr, Jason Loehr, Ashley Loehr, Christina Loehr and Amanda Loehr; seven great grandchildren.

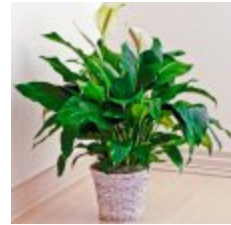
