Shelton, WA—Graveside Memorial Services for Mr. Norman Cecil Carter, Jr., 67, who entered into rest September 21, 2008, after a courageous struggle with cancer, will be conducted Saturday, October 4th, 2008 at 1 o'clock in Jackson Memorial Cemetery. Rev. Rick Statham officiating.

Mr. Carter was a native of Ellenton, SC a former resident of Thomson, GA, having made Shelton, WA his home. He proudly served 20 years with the U.S. Coast Guard retiring in 1983 and in 2004 retired from U.S. Immigration with 20 years of service. 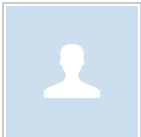


“ Pat, Mike, Shelby and Carolyn... I wish we could be there with you all.

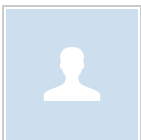

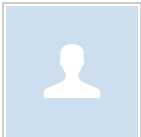

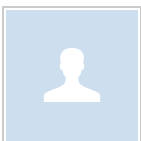
