North Augusta, SC—Funeral Services for Mr. Norman A. "Bobby" Dodd, 77, of North Augusta, SC, who entered into rest October 16, 2012, will be conducted Monday morning at 11 o'clock from the First Baptist Church of North Augusta. Pastor Doug Page, Rev. Mr. Dodd was a native of Clayton, North Carolina, having made North Augusta his home for the past 54 years. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of North Augusta where he had served as a Deacon, Training Union Director, Brotherhood Director, a Sunday night Usher and a Sunday School Teacher for the past 41 years. He also served on two Pastor Search Committees, the Food Service Committee, Laces 4 Love Committee and the Church Volunteer Visitation Program. Mr. Dodd was a U.S. Army Veteran and a 1958 graduate of the Medical University of South Carolina with a Bachelor of Science in Pharmacy. He began his career in pharmacy in 1958 with Peoples Drug Store, was part Owner of Gardelle's Drug Store for 15 years and for the past 30 years has worked for Revco, CVS, Winn-Dixie and Publix Pharmacies. Mr. Dodd was the husband of the late Patty Stewart Dodd.

Survivors include two daughters and sons-in-law, Ginger and Rad Vanzant,

Johnston and Beth and Mike Plummer, Appling; a granddaughter, Montana Vanzant; a brother, Marshall Dodd, Raleigh, NC; a sister, Maxine Weight, Georgetown, TX.
