Belvedere, SC – Funeral Services for Mr. Paul "Skip" Wilk, 76, who entered in to rest November 15, 2017, will be conducted Saturday morning at 11 o'clock from the Belvedere First Baptist Church. Rev. Mr. Wilk was a native of Collinsville, CT, having made North Augusta his home for the past 54 years. He was a graduate of Neptune High School, Neptune, NJ, Class of '59 and later graduated from Augusta Tech with a degree in Electronics Technology. Mr. Wilk was a U.S. Army veteran and was stationed in Korea during his service. He was a member of the Jessie C. Lynch Memorial American Legion Post 71 for fifteen years, where he was an integral part of the legion's ceremonial corps. Mr. Wilk was a member of the Belvedere First Baptist Church and retired from CSX as a Locomotive Engineer with 36 years of service. He volunteered with the Belvedere Fire Department for 23 years and with the Red Cross, Aiken, SC, for three years. Mr. Wilk enjoyed coaching youth baseball, fly fishing, golfing and watching fast pitch softball.

Survivors include his wife of 54 years, Delle S. Wilk; two sons, Scott (Evie) Wilk, Glenn (Becky) Wilk; a daughter, Jolene (Alan) Timmons; five

grandchildren, Lindsey (Travis) Lane, Clay Timmons, Haleigh Timmons, Andrew Wilk, Emily Wilk; two brothers, Dick Wilk, Jim (Annette) Wilk.
