North Augusta, SC – Memorial Services for Mrs. Peggy Seigler, 42, of North Augusta, SC, who entered into rest May 20, 2015, will be conducted Saturday afternoon at 2 o'clock in Grace United Methodist Church. Rev. James D. Dennis and Dr. G. Daniel McCall officiating. Interment will be private.

Mrs. Seigler was a native of Gainesville, FL, having made North Augusta her home for the past 19 years. She was a former member of Fairview Presbyterian Church, a current member of Grace United Methodist Church and a member of the Augusta Kiwanis Club. Mrs. Seigler was employed with the Augusta Convention and Visitor Bureau as V.P. of Sales and Marketing with almost a decade of service. Prior to working at the CVB, she was in a marketing position with the City of Augusta and was a former news anchor with WRDW News 12. Mrs. Seigler received her Masters in Public Administration from Augusta State University and her Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Florida. Her career in hospitality began by working summers at Walt Disney World. She was preceded in death by her brother-in-law, Jerry Seigler.

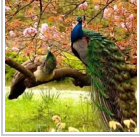
