North Augusta, SC—Funeral Services for Peggy Hodges Turner, 82, of Woodlawn Lane, who entered into rest May 12, 2017, will be conducted Monday afternoon at 3 o'clock from First Baptist Church of North Augusta. Ms. Turner was a native of Brewton Alabama, a former resident of Selma, Alabama, having made North Augusta her home for the past 63 years. She was a member of First Baptist Church of North Augusta since 1954, where she served as a Sunday School Teacher to the High School Girls and was a member of the June Faigler Sunday Class. Ms. Turner founded Neptune Dive and Ski in her garage in 1962, and later relocated the business to Georgia Avenue, where it has been in business for 55 years. She enjoyed playing cards, studying history and collecting artifacts and old bottles. Ms. Turner loved her family, as well as many others who looked up to her and called her mother. She was preceded in death by her parents, Ed Lee Hodges and Katherine Torrence; her former husband, James Edward Turner and a daughter, Renee T. Paschal.
