



Pierce Fields Mobley

July 16, 1947 - September 23, 2023

North Augusta, SC – Mr. Pierce Fields Mobley, 76, entered into rest at his home September 23, 2023. Private Memorial Services will be held at a later date.

Pierce was born July 16, 1947, in Langley, SC, was raised in Augusta, GA, having made North Augusta, SC his home for the past 53 years. He attended Sacred Heart Catholic Church in his youth and graduated from Richmond Academy, where he excelled as an athlete, especially as a basketball player. Pierce began his career as a Respiratory Therapist with St. Joseph's Hospital and retired from Trinity Hospital with 46 years of service. He was an avid South Carolina Gamecock fan and a sports enthusiast, with soccer being one of his favorite spectator sports. Fitness and weight training was paramount throughout Pierce's life and well into his senior years. He spent most of his time training at the Family YMCA and Health Central gyms. Pierce was not only a man of great stature, but he was also a great role model and mentor to all who knew him. He was looked up to as a larger-than-life figure, especially by his children and grandchildren. Pierce never missed a ball practice or game and was a very present and loving husband, father, and grandfather. He truly had a servant's heart, genuinely cared for the well-being of others, and will be fondly remembered as the ultimate caregiver.

He was preceded in death by his mother, Ora Lee Townson Heldt; his father-

in-law and mother-in-law, Walter and Gladys Brewington; and his sister, Judith Ann Harkins. He is survived by his beloved wife of 52 years, who he affectionately referred to as his “Princess”, Vicky Mobley; two sons, Darren Waters (Candace) and Kelley Mobley (Bethany); five grandchildren, Ann Michelle Campbell-Kelly (Rob), Warren Mobley, Tanner Mobley, Mallory Owens, and Anna Owens; a great-grandson, Liam Campbell-Kelly; and his nieces, Melissa, Charlotte, Amanda, Judith, and Amy.
